Warren County JRAC Meeting Minutes September 7, 2023

Members Present: Judge Hunter Reece - Circuit Court Judge

The meeting was called to order at 9:11 a.m., with a quorum present.

Minutes: The minutes from June 15, 2023, were presented. A motion to approve them was made by JoAnn Treece, seconded by Chad Montgomery, the motion was carried unanimously.

Old Business: Judge Reece relayed to the group that Amy of Crossroads Recovery had begun providing Life Skills classes at the Warren County Jail. She is providing two 2-hour classes weekly, one for males and one for females. She is currently serving approximately 10 males and 5 females. The chemical addictions grant supporting this ends September 2023.

Judge Reece informed the group that the \$168,000 of Opioid Match grant funds would be used in year one to support Warren County Health Department education/outreach initiatives. Initiative examples would include things such as guest speakers being brought in for school convocations and/or evening public presentations regarding substance abuse education. Judge Reece encouraged the group to contact him with any ideas on any speakers. Danielle Snider suggested the speaker who presented at the 2023 Mental Health Summit held in Indianapolis and that she would try to find out who the person was.

The Judge said that Fountain and Warren County had contributed to match the opioid grant allowing for \$134,000 to operate the transportation grant for a 3rd year. The Judge stated that the goal for the first year was to provide 500 rides. He reported that 1,200+ rides were provided with 1900 manhours and approximately 22,000 miles were driven. The Judge relayed that the Mac Van Director, Tammy Nickle, had retired. Amanda Burton stated they had hired a replacement, but that she was currently on maternity leave. He also shared that Community Action would be hiring a full-time driver to predominately serve grant riders.

New Business: Judge Reece shared with the group that there will be a Mental Health Summit in Wabash Indiana on October 13, 2023, that specifically targets rural community issues. Currently, Amanda Burton and JoAnn Treece plan to be in attendance.

Dani Snider shared with the group that the second quarter 2023 electronic monitoring report was submitted by WCRCC and the Warren County JRAC second quarter report had been turned in to the state.

Discussion was held regarding the increased need for interpretation for the court. Judge Reece forecasted that the Court will likely need to contract with an in person interpreter for 2024, due to increased defendants who do not speak English, as the current telephone interpreters through Language Line are inadequate for this volume.
